Tass: Oh.

Tass: I thought we were getting them out!

Rev: I guess that means Tass is eating his first.

Tass: I don't know what they are, but they're adorable.

Rev: Yeah. So, Rev from the past, remind us what everybody picked for their thing, because I currently sure do not remember the German names of the candies you picked.

SFX: RECAP MUSIC

Rev: Niederegger, Rumpflaume, Vingummi Spunk, Dickmann's Schoko Strolche, Verpoorten.

SFX: RECAP MUSIC FADES

Rev: All right. So Tass, describe to us what you got. First, I have to say I love — I listen to a lot of actual play podcasts, and almost all of them are the players, the cast, the GM talking about, like, all the alcohol that their listeners send them. I love that our listeners send us snacks.

Megan: [Laughs]

Tass: Yes, thank you.

Rev: [Laughs]

Tass: OK. So what I'm seeing is a little red package that is heart-shaped, and I am opening it to reveal some sort of chocolate.

Megan: Heart-flavored chocolate.

Tass: It is heart-flavored chocolate. I'm trying to analyze, here. Like, I can see some little tinges of red, underneath the chocolate ...

Jake: If you don't fucking bite into candy right now, I will bury you.

Megan: Do it, do it.

Tass: It's got a good ...

Jake: Oh, my god.

Tass: Good aroma.

Jake: Oh, my god.

Megan: [Laughs] Just waving it in front of his nose.

Tass: Hating my palate.

Jake: I'm gonna bully you into eating this candy.

Rev: He was just waving it in front of Jake's nose.

Tass: [Laughs] All right, here we go.

Rev: Oh, that's a face. What's the middle of it?

Tass: I don't know.

All: [Laugh]

Tass: It looks like coconut, but it doesn't taste like coconut. Or if it is, it's the mildest coconut I have ever tasted.

Megan: Can I see? Yeah, it absolutely looks like a ... Like a Mounds bar.

Tass: Yeah. I give this a ... I'll give this a 7/10, as far as chocolatey ...

Rev: And we're calling it a maybe coconut?

Tass: A maybe coconut. I don't know. It's very mild, but it's good.

Rev: Did someone whisper coconut in the other room as you bit into it?

Tass: This is a chocolate coconut LaCroix.

Rev: [Laughs]

Megan: [Laughs]

Jake: Ugh ...

Tass: OK, Who's up?

Jake: I'll go.

Rev: OK.

Jake: I've got Rumpflaume, and it's got a picture of a fruit on it that is purple. And I should probably know what the fruit is.

All: [Laugh]

Jake: What is that?

Rev: Listeners, I guess, start sending us fruit instead.

Megan: And I think that looks like maybe a ...

Kim: Everyone in the cast has scurvy.

All: [Laugh]

Kim: Please send them limes.

Jake: The teeth don't go back in.

All: [Laugh]

Megan: Is it like a ... Like a current?

Jake: I don't know. I mean, it is currently in my hands.

All: [Begrudgingly laugh]

Megan: Eat your candy.

Jake: I am uncivilized. I mean it's just like a chocolate covered whatever this fruit is.

Tass: I figured mine out. It's marzipan.

Megan: Oh.

Kim: Oh, nice.

Tass: It's very mild, but yeah, absolutely.

Jake: I'm not getting a lot of flavor off of the fruit filling, off this. Mostly getting hit by the dark chocolate. It was good. Got a nice texture. Don't mind if I do.

Rev: [Chuckles]

Megan: OK. I got ... Oh no, I got a little box. It kind of looks like a little cigarette. Almost a cartridge — that's not right.

All: [Laugh]

Megan: Let me just plug in the cigarette box. Yeah, it's wrapped in plastic. It says Spunk on one side. And then it says Vingummi — I think it's some sort of gummy. And then it looks like, what, maybe a jelly bean? Sorry, a parrot that was turned into a jelly bean.

Rev: Oh.

Megan: Yeah. See?

Rev: Oh! Yeah.

Tass: Oh, that's adorable.

Megan: So it's parrot-flavored ...

Kim: Parrot-flavored gummies.

Rev: Oh, man.

Megan: Jelly beans.

Rev: Bertie Botts is just going wild.

Tass: [Laughs]

Megan: All right, all right. Let me see here ...

Jake: I've changed my mind. [Laughs]

Megan: You don't like it?

Jake: As I've finished this. I did like a nibble for the examination, and then I just did the rest of it. And that was too much. I think this is a nibbling candy.

Megan: Oh, my gosh. Oh my gosh!

Rev: What? Are they gummy parrots?

Megan: They're little ... They're little like ... They're like little like jujubes, but they look like little parents. Oh my gosh!

Tass: Oh, let me see. That's adorable.

Rev: [Laughs]

Jake: And all of them down the hatch.

Megan: [Mouth full] Yeah, they're kinda hard to chew.

Rev: I was gonna say, they're crunchy. That's surprising.

Megan: No, no.

Rev: Oh.

Megan: They're like a hard gummy.

Jake: She's like, "No, no. My teeth just are weak. My teeth are brittle."

Kim: Again, please send the cast vitamin C.

All: [Laugh]

Jake: Citrus, please!

Megan: I want some calcium to go with the vitamin C, thanks.

Tass: Jake, yours are rum plums.

Megan: Hmm.

Jake: That makes sense. Via by the name.

Tass: Rum plum, covered in dark chocolate.

Jake: That was my favorite member of Cats.

Tass: [Laughs] Go RumPlum DarkChocolate.

Megan: And these are green and orange and yellow. So they're like kind of the citrusy-er flavors of gummies.

Rev: OK.

Jake: What is a hard gummy? I mean, that just sounds like a gummy that's gone bad. Hard and gummy sound like ... Like they can't occupy the same space. Yeah, this feels like a stale gummy.

Megan: Yeah, I like it.

Rev: So it's not like a Mike and Ike, where it's got a hard shell and then gummy in the middle. Just a stale gummy?

Jake: It's just a stale-ass gummy.

Tass: You just gotta — you just gotta gum it for a little bit.

Jake: That's a gummy that's been out there for a while.

Megan: I like harder gummies. Like I like to put my gummy worms in the freezer.

Rev: Hmm.

Megan: My gummy bears in the freezer, because it makes them hard. And then you can just kind of like ...

Rev: Yeah.

Megan: Savor them for a while. This is impossible to chew. I can't — I just have to swallow them whole, I think.

All: [Laugh]

Megan: Like a pill.

Jake: I have not gotten through this one yet.

Rev: All of Megan's audio is just shot for the rest of the day.

Megan: It's pretty bad.

Tass: What's Kim got?

Kim: So I have no idea what this is, but it looks delicious. And it comes in three varieties. It comes in a white, milk, and dark chocolate. I'm going to do the dark chocolate one.

Rev: Yeah, I just remember it being something "Dickmann's"

Tass: Yeah.

Kim: It's quite tall, and it has, like, a kind of like ... Like, waffle wafer on the bottom.

Jake: Ooh.

Tass: Oh, yeah.

Kim: And I think there's like some, like, marshmallow action inside of here, so let's try it.

Tass: This might just be my bad eyesight, but from the screen, it looks like just a chocolate little ghost from Pac-Man.

Jake: I was gonna say like a chocolate Bullet Bill.

Rev: Hmm.

Tass: Oh, good call.

Kim: Yeah, it's great. It's basically a marshmallow dipped in chocolate that's sitting on top of, like, a waffle cone.

Jake: I've gotta find these in this box.

Tass: Yeah, that's amazing.

Rev: And then mine is ... It looks like a little treasure chest. Um, Verpoorten.

Tass: Let's see what treasure is inside.

Rev: Hmm, what's inside?

Jake: [Laughs] Oh, something just awakened in him!

Rev: Wow.

Tass: OK, what do we got?

Rev: I think, whatever it is, it is very alcohol based.

Tass: [Laughs]

Kim: Oh, good.

Rev: I think. Someone else who's not opposed to having some alcohol right now, find this inside of your ...

Megan: What is it?

Rev: A little yellow ...

Megan: I'm gonna get fucked up before we record.

Jake: Yeah. Megan's like, "I'll take it. I probably have the lowest tolerance of anybody on this cast."

Megan: Oh, whatever.

Rev: Like, mouth wise, this feels like I just took a shot of alcohol. Like the heat that's in the back of my throat and my tongue.

Tass: OK. Both of them have glassy eyes.

Kim: Say the alphabet backwards.

Megan: Fuck, I need a chaser for this.

Rev: Right?

Megan: Holy shit.

Rev: Like it feels — it's very strong.

Megan: Oh, boy. Uff da.

Rev: Yeah?

Megan: Yeah, that's strong. And it's just coating my mouth now.

Rev: [Laughs]

Megan: Yeah. So mine, the name Spunk apparently comes from a Pippi Longstocking book. And she invents a word for which she can find no use. So the box, "Bears the name Spunk and a drawing of a "fantasy animal" made by an eight year old girl." So I guess that's what the parrot jelly bean is, is a "fantasy animal."

Rev: Huh.

Megan: And then they're in, like, some different ... They come in like different colors, these wine gums, and they're like four different flavors. But they also do salt licorice. Because the thing that I found first: "From the people that brought you salt licorice." And I was like, oh no!

Rev: No!

Megan: [Laughs]

Rev: I wonder if that's why, like, they're parrot-shaped. I remember Pippi Longstocking being on a pirate ship.

Tass: Nice. And just for update — I love researching all of these — the Verpoorten. Verpoorten is a brand of eggnog. It is —

Megan: What?

Tass: This is actually a "You have to be 21 to buy it," candy.

Rev: [Laughs]

Tass: It is dark chocolate with a liquid core of the very popular Verpoorten original eggnog liquor.

Rev: Well, thank you, Tech Girl, for sending us these treats.

Megan: Thank you!

Rev: All the way from Germany.

Kim: They're delicious.

Rev: Yeah. Thank you so much. And with that, it's time to let the recap roll.

SFX: RECAP MUSIC

Jake: "She still has some Chosen energy."

Megan: "That doesn't leave if you die?"

Tass: "No, that's weird. Like, you know, he was trying to collect the souls and stuff of Chosen, but not because, like, the energy stays in it. It pops."

Kim: "Maybe it was something about how you died, Cara. How did that happen?"

Rev: CARA: I told you earlier that we had to perform this on a plane where no human could see, much less truly exist. When I went through to do the strike, I fully went into the gods' plane. My body could not survive. I died there. Later, my body was retrieved and given burial.

Tass: "Damien, I don't know if we have a connection with what you gave me, but if you can hear me, I could really use your attention right now."

Rev: The three of you, like, going to work, putting these bones back to rest. There's this brief flash behind you, and then again. And you turn, and Tass is gone.

So as you're touching the ash on the ground, you get this kind of rolling memory of Damien throughout his life. And there's this moment where you see a large book laid out, and someone has some documents and some stamps. Very clearly, you see them looking down at the book. They erase a longer name, and write a shorter one. And in this moment, you realize somewhere along his many years of life, Damien was forced to change Ó Dubhghail to O'Doyle.

SFX: RECAP MUSIC FADES

Rev: Tass, you and Damien appear back inside the catacombs, and Kim and Jake and Megan are right there as you both appear.

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Ah, fuck.

Megan: "Oh, my god."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: God damn.

Tass: "Hey. Sorry, Sorry, sorry, sorry, sorry, I just ... I don't know. I needed some input."

Jake: I slap him, right across the face.

Tass: "Ah!"

Jake: "Don't be TJ!"

Tass: "Sorry."

Megan: "Hey, Damien."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Hey. How's it going?

Megan: "Pretty good. How are you?"

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Were you guys ... Tass said — yes, awesome dog. Were you

guys burying bones?

Megan: "Reburying bones."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Oh, OK.

Kim: "Damien!"

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Yeah?

Kim: "Very important question. Hi. Your name, it wasn't always O'Doyle, right?"

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Yeah. Uh, quite a while ago, I had to have it changed when I was getting some paperwork done.

Kim: "Ó Dubhghail."

Megan: "No!"

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Yeah. Why? What?

Tass: "Fucking what?!"

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: What?

Tass: "What did I miss in 5 minutes?"

Kim: "Well, you left! And so I was trying to have a vision as to where you had gone. And I had a vision of Damien taking you away. And then I had another vision about Damien, and I found out that his name used to be Ó Dubhghail."

Tass: I instantly pick her up, hug her, spin her around and set her down. And I grab Damien by the sleeve, and I start tugging him into the graveyard.

Rev: As you start to pull him across to the graveyard, you both touch the water and react violently.

Tass: "Oh, god!"

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Fuck!

Tass: "Oh, I don't know. That didn't do that last time."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: What is that?

Tass: "I guess, well, holy water."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Why would you do that?

Tass: "I got past it last time, but I had to go a little feral in a fight."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: [Groans]

Tass: "Sorry. Sorry, sorry, sorry,"

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Just right in the gut.

Tass: "Oh, I had such, such promising news all of a sudden, too. I was so happy about this." And I turn around, like having to do the kind of waddle step to turn myself towards them while I'm in pain. "He's looking for the resting place of his mother."

Kim: "Damien, what was your mom's first name?"

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Cara.

Jake: "Yo, your mom's in that tomb!"

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: What?

Jake: "Yeah! We talked to her!"

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: The energy behind that was like, we're gonna pimp your ride.

All: [Laugh]

Jake: "I'm just ... It's — what are the odds?"

Kim: Your mom's dead, and she's in that tomb!

Jake: Well, we knew she was — or I mean I guess, I don't know exactly what her fate was. But, like, we knew her fate was, like, locked away somewhere.

Megan: "This is amazing."

Jake: "She's in there!"

Rev: He looks confused, and then pushes through this burning and paddles across this creek.

Jake: [Shudders]

Rev: Gets out on the other side.

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: [Pained] Oh, what's up, dog?

Rev: The dog comes over and sniffs him and growls a little.

Megan: I'm following after him with the vial, and I put my hand up to the Kirkegrim. "It's okay."

Kim: Yeah. I will jump across.

Jake: Yeah. I'll start heading back inside and moving the statue again.

Tass: I just sit down, smiling and watching.

Rev: Damien turns and runs inside the mausoleum.

Jake: Yeah, I'll move the statue out of the way and help him lift the lid off again.

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: How in the world did you find this?

Jake: "Baba Yaga told us to come here?"

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Keanu Reeves?

Jake: [Laughs] The Boogeyman?

Megan: The Boogeyman? [Laughs]

Jake: "No. Like actual ..."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Oh.

Jake: "Have we not talked to you about that at any point?"

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: No, I just — my mind doesn't go there.

Megan: I just binged John Wick this weekend, so.

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Yeah. I was playing the video game earlier. It's pretty good.

Jake: "She told us that we needed to come here to get, like ... To learn something from her. I mean, we didn't really know who she was or anything, but ..."

Megan: "Damien, your mom was a Chosen. She was The Chosen that helped put away Death last time."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Oh.

Jake: "And if we give her this water, she can — we can, like, communicate with her again. But I don't know if you've got something else that we should be doing instead."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: I was gonna use this.

Rev: And he reaches in his pocket and pulls out the soul gem.

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: I was gonna use this to bring her back, so I could let go of the deal I made with Callidus.

Jake: "I mean, if that's what you want to do. Like, we already spoke to her. And I mean, if you bring her back or whatever, then it's fine. Whatever you need to do. Dude, this is — this is the terminus of your journey."

Megan: "Do you want to talk to her first?"

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Uh, I don't know. Like, what if I talk to her and she's like, no, don't do it. And then I have spent my whole life trying to ... Uh ... No. No, I'm just gonna do it.

Kim: "OK."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: I'm just gonna do it.

Kim: "Yeah."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Right? Like, fuck it. Just do it. This is what I've been looking for forever. And it's why I made a deal with the devil. To become a devil, so I could live a really long time. So I could figure out what happened to my mom. And you've all just said she was a Chosen, and she died for some reason? Stopping Death, whatever that means?

Jake: "Yeah, dude. It's a lot. But ..."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Like my memory of her is nothing. I have no memory of her. Like, my first memories are when I was, like, nine years old. There's nothing before that. And I was just a kid. And I think that ... I don't think, I know. Those memories were taken from me on purpose to stop me from feeling the pain of whatever I had been through, or lost.

Kim: "Whoa. Strohm was present when your mom died, and she also doesn't remember anything."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: She fucking what?

Megan: "OK, so ..."

Rev: He lays down.

All: [Laugh]

Megan: "Yeah. Yeah, that's fair. That's fair. Just get ... Just ... Yeah, on the floor. Just put ... Put your face on the, like, cool stone."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Yeah, OK.

Megan: "OK ..."

Rev: And the dog comes over and sits next to him, and he pets the dog with his other hand.

Megan: "Yeah, just give him pets. OK. So long story short, Death was doing some bad shit. Or I guess the vessel that Death was in was bad, and was doing some bad shit. So all the other gods got together with three other people who are Baba Yaga, who can do magic, and Strohm, who's an oracle, and The Chosen, who was your mom. And the three of them came together and said, 'Hey, yo, we gotta stop Death because this is really bad, and we don't have the power to do it. But maybe if we do something else, like with the gods, they can do it.' So then they went to the gods, and the gods were like, 'Yeah, we can do it, but we gotta go somewhere that's really dangerous to do it.' So they came together with this, like, plan of how to do it. And they trapped Death, and all the gods got around Death. And your mom crossed over into this plane where the gods lived, and it was outside of where humans could exist. And she gave her life to use her abilities, to use her weapon. And she ... And she kind of caged Death. Obviously, death still exists because people die, but the horrors that he was causing wouldn't happen anymore."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: OK. So, that's ... That's a lot. So she died for a good reason, at least, is what you're saying? For a good cause?

Megan: "The best reason she could see. It was the ultimate sacrifice, to give up her life, to give up her love of everybody that meant so much to her, her family, to protect."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: OK. So like, me bringing her back is not gonna, like, undo that or anything, right?

Megan: "Uh ... no."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: What was that 'Uh'?

Megan: "Like, it was already kind of undone. But like, not exactly. But then it was redone,

so it's fine."

Kim: "Yeah. Death is gone. The vessel, avatar of Death is done with. I don't think bringing

your mom back would undo that."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: OK.

Jake: "Because the only reason she died in the doing was basically because there

wasn't, like, a safe laneway for her to get to him. Like, her dying wasn't a requisite part of

the thing. It was just something they couldn't figure out how to avoid."

Megan: "Yeah. So that's why we're here, because we found out that apparently we're

gonna have to redo this ritual? This spell? And we don't have enough information. We all

know that we kind of play a part in it, but we don't know how it was done or why it was

done. And so we had to come talk to somebody who was there and hadn't lost all their

memories."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: OK, so ... Whoa. Now, OK. So in the car ...

Rev: He rolls over onto his back and looks up at the ceiling, and the dog licks his cheek.

Kim: Aww ...

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Tass said that the energy of The Chosen was still inside, and he

wasn't sure what was going to happen to it or what to do with it.

Megan: "Yeah."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: What's gonna happen to it if I bring her back?

Kim: "I don't know. Will she be The Chosen again?"

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: I don't know. I'm not gonna bring her back just to die again. Oh, wait. No, you said that she doesn't have to die to do the ritual.?

Kim: "Yes."

Jake: "No."

Kim: "She does not have to die."

Megan: "Correct. We know that it was just how it was at the time, because they didn't have any other way. But we don't know if she's actually supposed to be a part of it when it happens again. We don't exactly know what that role looks like."

Kim: "And, you know, like now that we know that that's a possibility, that might happen, and we have some time to think about it. If we were going to do that ritual again, when we do it again, surely with all of our various resources, we can think of a way so that the person who needs to strike the final blow can do that and not die. There has to be a way that you can cross that veil and make it back."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: I'm gonna be honest. That last part kind of ... You kinda lost me.

Megan: "We're gonna try to not require the person who has to kill whatever it is we're supposed to kill to die this time."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Yeah.

Megan: "Yeah. We still got a lot of question marks that we have to fill in."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Yeah.

Megan: "And that's kind of why we came here. So we don't really know much more than this."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Bringing her back, is there a way to know what's gonna happen to whatever energy is in her?

Jake: "My best guess is that when she comes back, it'll stay within her. But she can relinquish it, because we've seen Tass do it. So if she didn't want it ..."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Oh.

Jake: "She could give it up, right?"

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Yeah.

Jake: "He gave it up so he could take your power."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Yeah. Oh, that's what that, like, light was that left him?

Megan: "Yeah."

Jake: "It seems like what she's got is like the original, and Tass's is like a lot further down the line, so. But they're the same concept."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Oh, OK. Like it didn't leave him and come here?

Megan: "No, no, no. So when it left your mom, when she died, it didn't have anywhere to go because she was in a place that humans can't be. And so it just stayed with her body. And so when they brought her back and buried her, it just stayed with her."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: OK.

Jake: Um, I don't know if this is something I actually have the means to do. Can I see if Damien's got whatever in his head, that he could be a vessel for The Chosen?

Megan: Ooh.

Rev: Why don't you roll Investigate a Mystery?

Kim: Oh, shit.

Jake: Seven.

Rev: All right, you get a hold 1.

Jake: What's being concealed here?

Rev: So you turn and open up your magical sight to Damien. And in this place, you can see the torch light kind of flickering off of his skin, and the glow from him. And for a brief moment, you do see this crystal in that spot in his head, and you can see that it's filled with this kind of pulsing red energy. So you do see a crystal, but right now it is full.

Jake: Yeah. I want to, like, put a finger on his forehead. Be like, "You've got a thing in your head, too. You've got the same crystal that, like, your mom has, that holds the energy of The Chosen, that Tass had. That I have. But yours has got, I'm guessing, demon-ness in it. Like a red — like a swirling red energy. But how fucking poetic would it be if you were The Chosen that stood with us when we did this thing?"

Kim: "Does everyone have these crystals except for me?"

Megan: "You can see them, Jake?"

Jake: "Yeah, sort of. Like metaphysically. Like, magically."

Megan: "So then do we all have like different auras? Is this like a different, like, color powers? Like every time we hit that ghoul with a different type of power, it was like a different color went through its brain."

Rev: Yeah, I think this is a continuation of, like, you glancing at him and getting this sense. As you look around the room, even out the door where Tass is, you can see the real dull red that's the same color as Damien's. And in Megan's you can see the color of The Empath, that pink and purple. And with Kim, you also see this very vibrant white light. Everyone has a full gem. Except for Tass's, which is ... It just seems diluted.

Jake: "Yeah, we've all got one."

Kim: [Gasps] "Really?"

Jake: "Yeah. Yours has, like, the same white light that comes out of your eyes when you have a vision. And, Megan, yours has, like, the pinkish purple when you do, like, a Jinx on stuff."

Kim: "Fuck yeah! Crystal!"

Jake: "Yes."

Kim: [Laughs]

Jake: "Tass's looks like it's like the same as Damien's, but kind of like, muddied. Because he's, like, half-demon."

Megan: "Yeah. So it all is kind of coordinated with where our powers come from."

Jake: "Because we're all a vessel, in one way or another."

Rev: Yeah, because I want to complete this picture. That even though your phones don't work down here, like I imagine Jake opening up his phone and looking at himself. And what you see in your crystal is like shocks of lightning and torrents of fire. Just very small, like, elements roiling around.

Jake: I didn't know my phone camera had this. This would have cleared this up way earlier.

Rev: If I knew this filter was available on Snapchat.

All: [Laugh]

Rev: But yeah, I think what Megan said is exactly right. Like as you look at everybody, you get this sense that earlier you understood it as the potential to be a Chosen, and now it seems like it's the potential to, like, store great power. It's just The Chosen is the only great power you knew of at the time.

Megan: Cool.

Jake: "Damien, I think ... I think you can bring her back, and it's gonna be fine. And if she wants to relinquish her ability or whatever, then she can do that. And if it's like, I don't know, to someone in particular, it probably could be, because we've kind of made that happen before. But I think yours is gonna be empty once you do, and you, like, finish out your deal. And then maybe you could take it, you know? If she's ready to just move on and find her final rest or something. I'm just saying, you can do your thing. You don't have to worry. This is gonna be fine. You can free yourself. You can bring your mom back. And then, it's a conversation. Whatever you want to happen from there, the world's your oyster."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: OK. OK, uh ... Everybody stand back?

Megan: Yeah, I'll hold out a hand and help him up off the floor.

Jake: [Laughs] I love the visual that he said that from the floor. Just, everyone stand back.

Megan: I think I go over to the doorway, too. "Hey, Tass?"

Tass: "Yeah?"

Megan: "Hey, I think we're doing this. So if you want to fly around, you know, maybe give that a shot. Because I don't know if you're gonna keep that power."

Tass: Um, I'm still just kinda ... I don't know, not quite meditating, but just sitting quietly, eyes closed. And I think I just smile at her and shake my head. "No, tell him to do what he's gotta do. I'm good."

Megan: "OK, man." And I'll turn back around. "Tass is good."

Rev: Damien moves over to his mom and holds the gem up, looking at it again. Looks back at the group of you, and slowly lowers it down onto her forehead. The gem instantly starts to melt across her brow, and you see the light from inside of it seep down into her forehead. And you see it move down her spine, tracing all the way down to the tailbone,

then back up. And it shifts over to where her heart would be, and the glow starts to pulse and get bigger and brighter. And then there is a blinding flash of light. In this moment, a couple of things happen. We see the skin and the clothing reform around Cara Ó Dubhghail. It's just like in the vision that Kim had. She's got long black hair, dark ebony skin, and bright green eyes. She sits up. And as she sits up, she yawns, and out of her mouth floats the gold energy of The Chosen. And it moves slowly around Damien, bathing him in this gold light. And the gray from his skin starts to fade, and the horns sink back into his head. And there stands a handsome black man in his late twenties, smiling down at his mother. The light hovers around him for another moment, and then darts into the cavern across the river, engulfing Tass. There is this flourish of gold energy as Tass tumbles through the air. And Tass, this is an experience unlike you had last time, because this is actually you generating what it is you will be. And the light forms around your body, down your hand, and we see your weapon starting to form. And in the darkness of the cave, now being cast in the light, the three of you and Damien look across this small creek as a golden shotgun forms in Tass's hand. He settles back down onto the ground, looking much like he looked the first day you all went out on a job.

SFX: CRITSHOW STINGER

Rev: All right. So heading down a path I was not expecting to go yet. Tass, let's talk about your new playbook.

Tass: Yeah, let's. So I am back to The Chosen.

Rev: Yeah.

Tass: This time with a different spin. A little more tailored to our situation.

Rev: Yeah, you are no longer Lana's Chosen, as much as The Chosen.

Tass: Yes, that is fair. So I do have the two starting moves. Destiny's Plaything. So, seeing visions at the beginning of the mystery, potentially. And the one that I did not have last time because it didn't really make sense with the way that we went about it, but totally does now: I'm Here For a Reason. There's something you are destined to do. Work out the details with the Keeper, based on your fate. You cannot die until it comes to pass. If you die in play, then you must spend a Luck point. You will then somehow recover or be

returned to life. And once your task is done, or you use up all your Luck, all bets are off. I think it's safe to say completing this ritual is the task.

Rev: Agreed.

Tass: And then from the one pick, I'm taking Invincible, because that has just sort of been the through line all the way through these playbooks, is this idea of the armor that I've had and that awareness, that kind of thing. So I always have the 2-armor that doesn't stack with any other protection. And just because it makes sense to move forward, I am retaining Medic. As for this glorious gilded weapon, because modern problems need modern solutions.

All: [Laugh]

Rev: Yeah, we were able to justify the shotgun, with the picks from the melee weapon list.

Tass: Absolutely. Because it already has — the shotgun is 3-harm, close, and messy.

Rev: Yeah.

Tass: So with the "haft" pick from the form, that makes sense because it's a two handed weapon.

Rev: Yeah.

Tass: So that's 2-harm. And then if I add "spikes" to that, it adds the appropriate damage that a shotgun has, plus the messy tag. And if I add — it really doesn't matter, either or. "Long" or "throwable" just adds the close tag, which is the same increment anyway. So on top of that I get one more pick. So it only makes sense that this is a magic weapon. So "artifact," as well.

Megan: Awesome.

Rev: Yeah. So you got a barrel that throws spikes. That's kind of what a shotgun is.

Tass: Yeah.

Jake: That's how, like, the person who first incepted the idea of a gun thought about it.

Rev: Yeah.

Jake: Like, what if we made a haft that throw spikes. And somebody was like, "Motherfucker, you're onto something."

Rev: "I like where you're going here."

Kim: Not even the magic ceilings are safe now.

Rev: [Laughs]

Tass: Not even. Oh, I gotta, like, name this thing now. I'll get there.

Megan: He's unstoppable.

All: [Laugh]

Tass: So my stats have shifted to -1 Charm, +2 Cool, +1 Sharp, +2 Tough, and -1 Weird. I think this has been a whole big shift in my demeanor, losing all the magic energy and all of that from the previous playbooks I've had. And lastly, my tags. My fate tags. The fate one specifically are "you can save the world" and "hidden allies," which I think makes sense, with all the —

Rev: Yeah. That you as a team have turned a lot of possible enemies into allies.

Tass: Absolutely. And so what makes sense for the doom tags, as opposed to the heroic ones, is "sympathy with the enemy," because of that same reason. And "the end of days," because we have seen what that means for mankind, at least. And that's what we're out to stop.

Rev: Yeah.

CRITSHOW STINGER

SFX:

Rev: So we're back in the underground catacomb. Tass, across the river, has just made his transformation, and Damien and his mom are standing in an embrace.

Tass: I think I'm still just sitting right where I was, just looking down at this gilded gun in bewilderment.

Jake: "OK, who's what now? Tass, you look ... You look fucking good, man."

Tass: "You, um ... You didn't, like, do something? You didn't spell this into being?"

Jake: "Oh, I can't spell. No, nobody — nobody affected anything. A thing just happened."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Yeah, like it circled around to me for a second, like it was checking me out, and then it tore off.

Kim: "Yeah, that gold light left Cara and it went into you, Tass."

Tass: I just very, very lightly nod.

Jake: I fucking, like, sprint out there and just, like, hug-tackle him.

Rev: Just, across the creek, spear tackle.

Jake: Yes. Just dive across the creek and tackle him.

Tass: "Oh, fuck!"

Jake: "You're Chosen!"

Tass: "Yeah I guess so, huh?"

Jake: "You're like, super legit Chosen! So, OK. So, Damien!" I like call back into the thing. "Are you human? Are you both just, like, human and good again?"

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Yeah, I think so.

Megan: "How's it feel?"

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Kind of squishy. A little weak.

Jake: "Yeah, dude! That's experience!"

Megan: "That's being human!"

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: My bones hurt. I'm sore. I think I'm hungry.

Jake: "And they always will."

Rev: [Laughs]

Megan: "Let's go to Steak 'n Shake."

Tass: "I have, um, I think, a couple of statements, here. Firstly, I really, really would like to shift our focus into how to survive in a god veil."

Kim: "Yep, absolutely. Yes. 100%. Yes."

Tass: "And second, dibs on not having somebody in my coffin on the way back."

All: [Laugh]

Jake: "Oh, yeah."

Megan: "Oh, yeah."

Jake: "Shit. I was really hoping that we'd just be able to hop a ride in the demon mobile. Get out of here."

Megan: [Gasps] "Damien, you don't have your car anymore, do you?"

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Oh.

Megan: "Aww."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Eh, I'll buy a car.

Jake: "Yeah man, there's cars out there. No worry."

Tass: "Yeah. Jakes had, like, 19 of them."

Jake: Yeah. How many you want? Hold on. Let me look at how many gear points I've got. I've got ...

Megan: I've got this PT Cruiser you can have.

Kim: [Laughs]

Rev: Cara lets go of Damien, and smiles down at him.

Rev: CARA: Seems like you have a story to tell me, young man. What exactly is going on here?

Megan: "Cara, do you remember the conversation that we had?"

Rev: CARA: Yes, like an echo.

Megan: "OK. Well, yeah. We came to get information about the ritual that you did. And Tass over there, that's Tass. He thought it would be a good idea to get into contact with Damien, who we're friends with. And we realized that you were his mom. And we've been trying to help him with his task. He's been trying to figure out a way to bring you back. And well, he did. So now you're here."

Rev: She turns and looks at him again.

Rev: CARA: You've grown since last I saw you. It's been, what, at least 15 years?

Rev: And he laughs.

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: It's been a lot longer than that. I had to make some bargains to

— you have to understand, I didn't know what happened to you. Those memories of you

... Before you were gone, they were all taken from me. I had nothing. I just learned what it

was that you were, what you did, right before we brought you back, so ...

Rev: She nods.

Rev: CARA: I thought maybe I was saving you the pain by taking those memories from

you, protecting you. But I see that in doing so, I put you on a very long road. Forgive me

for taking that from you.

Rev: And they hug again.

Kim: "You didn't take those memories from Strohm too, did you?

Rev: CARA: No.

Kim: "I can't figure out why she doesn't remember this ritual. Or I wonder if she didn't

even know the identity of your mom, Damien."

Rev: CARA: She and I were very close. If she couldn't remember it, I'm sure she didn't

remember me either. She and I worked together to find Baba Yaga and to find the gods.

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: You were close with Strohm?

Rev: CARA: Yes. Why?

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: [Grumbles]

Jake: No reason.

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: No reason.

Kim: "Our moms are friends! Look at that."

Megan: "Are those memories back, now? Or ... Like, what happened to them?

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Yeah. It's like she said about your conversation. It's like an echo, but it's becoming clearer.

Megan: I'll look at Kim. "I dunno, maybe Strohm's gonna be back up to speed now too, then?"

Kim: "Yeah, maybe. I should call her when we get reception."

Jake: [Laughs]

Megan: "Yeah, let's go get reception."

Rev: CARA: How do we get out of here? Where are we, exactly?

Jake: "We're in some kind of burial ground for, like, heroes?" Actually now, I'm kind of realizing now — I don't feel like I've done my due diligence on this place. "And I don't know how we get back, exactly. Do we just get back in our coffins?"

Tass: "I'm totally chill with the logic of it."

Kim: "Baba Yaga didn't say that there was a different way to get back, but I guess we didn't strictly ask her."

Tass: Yeah, I'm already getting in mine.

Rev: Damian and Cara are like ...

Rev: CARA: Where should we ...?

Jake: "Uh, we're gonna have to share. We're gonna have to do some, like, arrangement."

Kim: Megan and I are both pretty small. Maybe we could share one?

Megan: Yeah, but are Cara and Damian ... Like, if they're not small, can they fit in one together? Or is this like a Tetris thing, where it's like, you gotta put a small piece with the

big piece, because you can't put the two big pieces together?

Jake: Yeah, I think it's gonna be like a Kim and Damien and a Cara and Megan, here. "I

mean, just in case it does work, anything else we need to accomplish before we get out

of here?"

Megan: "I mean, the ghouls are taken care of, and there's nothing else in this, like,

mausoleum that I think we need to take with us. So ..."

Kim: "We got another vial of that water, right?"

Megan: "Yeah, I have it."

Kim: "OK."

Megan: "Didn't need to use it here, so ... Good to have, I guess, on hand." I want to go

over and say goodbye to the Kirkegrim.

Rev: Oh, yeah. You come over to it, and it starts wagging its tail as it's laying on the

ground.

Megan: I just hold its big face in my hands and I give it a kiss on the nose, and I say,

"Thank you so much for your help. I hope you're feeling better."

Jake: Yeah, I'll give him some pets for being a good boy.

Tass: Yeah, yeah.

Kim: Yeah. Can I scritch its belly? It's big, big belly?

Rev: Yeah.

Kim: Yes!

Rev: And I think that while you're doing that, like you're petting him on his side — that pet that you get to get your dog to like roll over, and it's like, "Yeah, well ... Yeah, OK."

Jake: Oh. Oh, no. My balance ...

Rev: Yeah.

Jake: Oh, gravity. So strong. Roll over.

Rev: Megan, Damien comes up next to you, and he's like ...

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Hey, thanks for talking me through all of that. Like, that was a lot. And I ... Yeah, thank you.

Megan: "Yeah, no problem. I can't imagine what it was like to just learn all that all at once. I'm sorry."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Yeah. I mean, it worked out way better than I thought it would, so.

Megan: "Yeah, it seems like that. I dig the new look."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Oh, thanks.

Megan: "I mean, like, for the record, I mean, I liked the old look, too. But you look happier."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Yeah. It's nice not having this weight. Like, I don't know if that makes sense, but there was this pull, that I had to be ... It was like part of being a demon. I had to be wheeling and dealing. It was like a drive that I couldn't control. So it's nice to not, like, have conversations with people, and have to be thinking in the back of my brain, if I have to help them with something, what am I gonna get out of it? Or, how do I spin this so that I can help them without having to not help them later? Or ... A lot of mental red tape.

Megan: "Yeah. That's ... That's a lot. I mean, good. I'm glad you're free to, you know, do whatever you want to do now, because you want to do it."

Rev: DAMIEN O'DOYLE: Yeah.

Rev: And he turns and he looks at his mom, who is also getting in on the belly scritches of the dog.

Kim: Hell yeah.

Jake: On receiving the belly scritches?

Rev: From the dog?

All: [Laugh]

Rev: Every time we pan over to the rest of the group, it's a different person on the ground, getting belly scritches. So with the dog thoroughly pet, is there anything else you all want to do down here?

Tass: I don't think so.

Rev: All right. So you all get into your respective coffins, some of you sharing coffins with others. You close the lids. You sit in silence for a couple of moments. And then again, you hear the repetition of the falling feet, and your coffin is lifted. And you feel yourself being walked, starting to go higher and higher. And then the footsteps stop. But it has not been nearly long enough. And you hear something outside, moving around the feet that have been moving you.

Rev: THE HARVESTMAN: You've taken something from my land. Now, you face The Harvestman.
